

Matthew 11:29 NIV says “Come to Me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”

To take His yoke upon ourselves and learn from Him means we bend our necks under the same yoke that Jesus did when He submitted to the will of the Father. The picture is of the double-oxen yoke, two oxen walking side by side at the same speed, working in harmony. Jesus calls it *My yoke*, which means He has allowed it to be laid upon His neck first. He’s not asking us to bend our necks to anything with which He hasn’t been saddled already. With His yoke firmly across our spirits, we find it easier to “walk the walk.” Getting in step with Him is almost unavoidable. We are a team.

and His love endures forever;

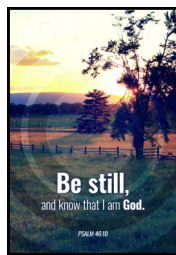
